

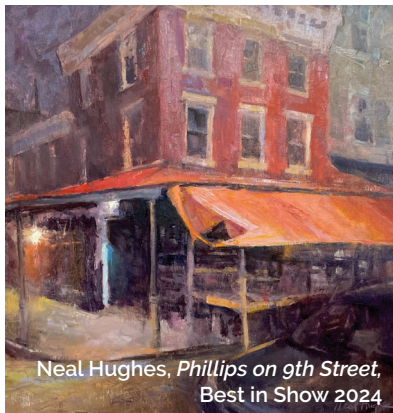

This year commemorates the 17th anniversary of the *Wayne Art Center Plein Air Festival*, recognized as one of the longest-standing and most cherished outdoor painting events in the nation. On Sunday, May 4, an exciting multi-day competition will kick off with 32 talented nationally renowned artists, who will find inspiration from the nearby charming towns, beautiful pastoral farms, rich historic architecture, and verdant landscapes that truly showcase the spirit of our region. Juror Larry Moore from Charleston, South Carolina will have the thrilling opportunity to choose the standout winning paintings and

celebrate the artists by presenting an impressive \$25,000 in awards at the much anticipated **Collectors' Preview & Sale** on **Saturday, May 10, from 6-9pm** at Wayne Art Center.

The artists will commence painting on **Sunday, May 4**, alongside fellow community painters, capturing the quintessential images on their canvases. The following six days, these accomplished artists may paint anywhere within a 25-mile radius of Wayne. In less than a day, plein air artists are adept at capturing the structure of the landscape and architecture in a particular light. These stunning works of art will be on display in the *Davenport*, *Ethel Sergeant Clark Smith* and *Vindinghoff Lobby Galleries* and available for sale at the ticketed Preview Party and from **Sunday, May 11 through Saturday, June 21, 2025**. 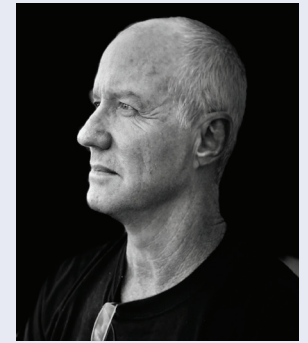

Juror Larry Moore

Juror Larry Moore of Charleston, South Carolina is a fine artist, instructor, illustrator and author. Moore's illustrious career as a visual communicator spans an impressive 50+ years. Some of his most noted plein air awards include Society of Illustrators, NY 2005 Gold Medal; Society of Illustrators,

NY annual exhibit 1995, 1997-2005; Luerzers Archive Top 200 Illustrators Worldwide, 2005; and Art Renewal Center International Competition 2023-2024. Moore's work is represented by galleries and in public and private collections throughout the US.

Abstraction from Nature Workshop with Larry Moore

May 12-15, 2025 | 9:30am-4:30pm



Moore will thoroughly explore the essential principles of design in abstract art, guiding you to discover new ideas, establish authenticity in your work, and determine how to interpret life, whether by pushing your process or embracing full abstraction.



Qiang Huang Still Life Workshop

May 13 & 14 | 9:30am-4:30pm

Qiang's approach to still life painting will be demonstrated with particular focus on creating dramatic set ups by observing the light distribution, and using bold and loose strokes to create a powerful and accurate representation on canvas. Using demonstrations and individual assistance, Qiang will explain his process of creating energetic paintings by manipulating values, colors, edges, and brushwork. Personal attention will be given to each student according to his or her current skill level and personal goals in art.



The History of Plein Air

In the mid-19th century, the Impressionists recognized the beauty of working with natural light, leading to a wonderful shift in the art world. The 1870s brought an exciting breakthrough with the introduction of paint in tubes, making outdoor painting or "en plein air" even more popular. Today, plein air painting continues to thrive, with a remarkable resurgence in its appreciation over the last two decades. Artists now gather in groups at designated locations, fostering a vibrant community where they can showcase their talents and creativity while connecting with one another and the public.
